The latest data from Podkarpackie labor market

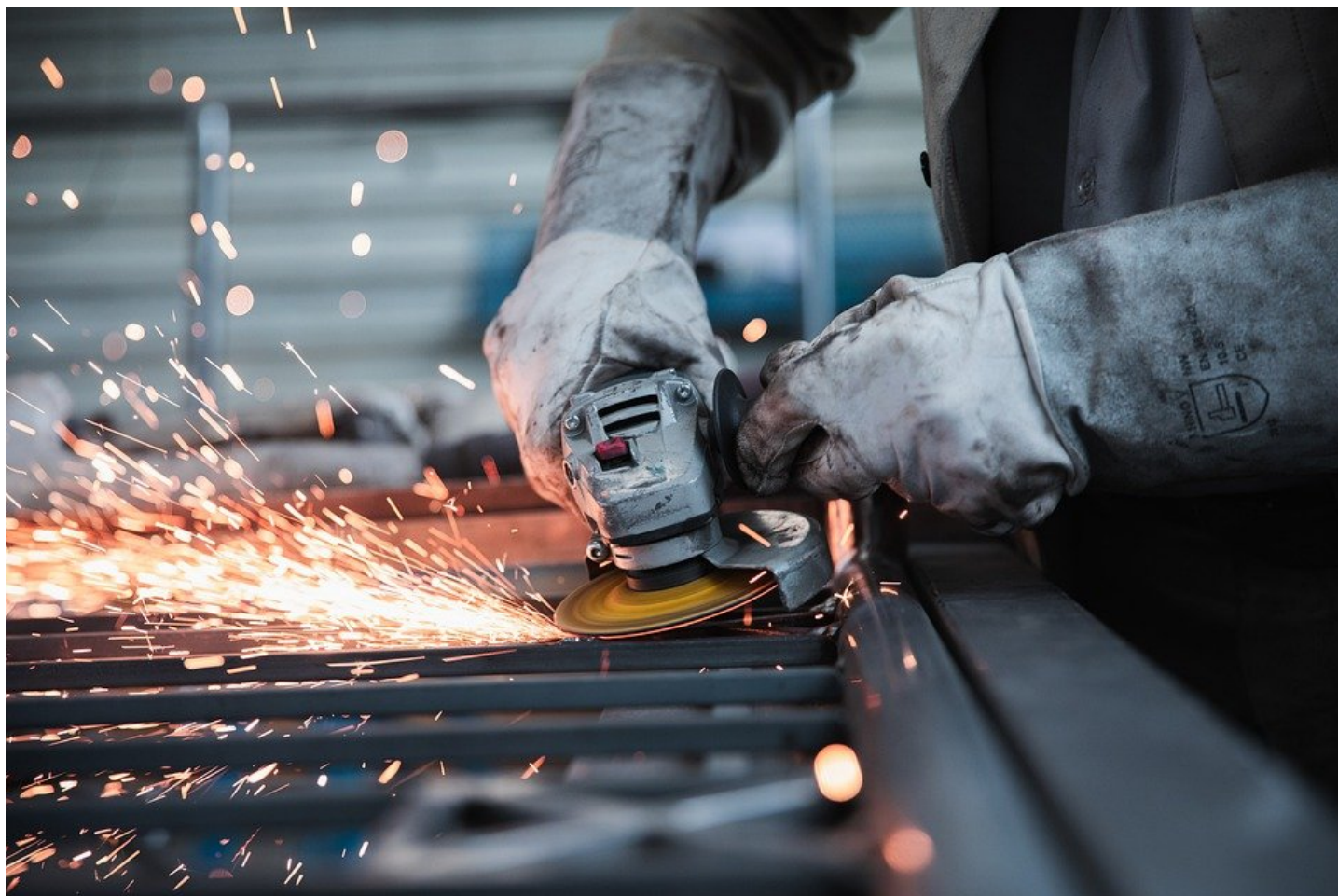

The latest data on the Podkarpackie labor market will be published here.

All data published below come from the [Statistical Office in Rzeszow](#).

- Population (on June 30th 2020) - **2 125 901**
- Unemployment rate - **8,9%**
- Average monthly gross salary in the enterprise sector - **4522,35 zł**
- Average employment in the enterprise sector (in thousand people) - **244,9**
- Number of registered business entities - **187 244**

Among the population employed in 2017 in the Podkarpackie Voivodeship, the largest number of people worked

in industry (34.8%), trade, repair of motor vehicles (14.1%) and education (12.8%).

The average employment rate in the Podkarpackie Province in entities employing more than 9 people in 2017 was 370 314 full-time jobs and was 3.6% higher than in 2014. Most were employed in the industry sector - 34.5%, education - 14.8% and trade; repair of motor vehicles - 12.6%.

In 2017, the average monthly gross wages and salaries in the Podkarpackie Province in entities employing more than 9 people amounted to PLN 3,837.17 (i.e. PLN 2,740.09 net with standard charges) and was higher by approximately PLN 425 compared to 2014 (i.e. by 12.5%; in 2014 - 2017, wages in Podkarpacie were systematically increasing, the highest increase compared to the previous year was recorded in 2017 - by 5.0%), while the average gross salary in the country was 4,527.89 PLN and increased compared to 2014 by about PLN 524 (i.e. by 13.1%). In 2017, the average salary in the Podkarpackie Province accounted for 84.7% of the national average (in 2014 - 85.2%). In the ranking of voivodships in terms of the wages, Podkarpacie was placed 15th.

Among the districts of Podkarpackie Province in 2017. Highest salary was recorded in the capital of the province (Rzeszow) - 4 510.48 zł. Compared to 2014, wages increased the least in Przemysl (by PLN 225) and in Niski powiat (by PLN 270). The highest increase was recorded in the following poviats: Leski (by PLN 585), Stalowa Wola (by PLN 535) and Mielecki (by PLN 515). The poviats with the lowest salaries in the voivodship are Strzyzowski (PLN 3,088.30) and Niski (PLN 3,097.08).

In 2017, the highest average monthly salaries were received by employees in the information and communication section (PLN 7,303.34), and the lowest in administration and supporting activities (PLN 2,452.34). Compared to 2014, average wages increased the most in other service activities (by 39.5%), administration and support activities (by 22.3%) as well as accommodation and catering (by 19.0%). The lowest increases were recorded in education (by 4.4%).

The indicators illustrating the working conditions are: the recognized occupational diseases, and the number of people injured in accidents at work. In 2017, in the Podkarpackie voivodship there were 6.06 injured persons per 1000 working people (in Poland - 6.80). In this respect, Podkarpacie is one of the safest regions of the country. In the years 2014 - 2017, this indicator showed a downward trend, both in the country and in the Podkarpackie Province.

Number of people registered in poviats labor offices in the province Podkarpackie is gradually decreasing (as in the whole country) - in 2018 this decrease was 8.8% compared to the previous year and 32.8% compared to 2015. In the registers at the end of 2018 there were 82.9 thous. unemployed people, which constitutes 9.8% of the number of people working in the region (according to GUS BAEL - 848 thousand) - that is, for every 10 working people there is one person registered as unemployed. During the year, over 117,000 jobs were made in poviats labor offices. registration of the unemployed, ie nearly 12% less than in the previous year. At the end of 2018, the number of unemployed in the country amounted to 968.9 thousand. persons and was lower than in the previous year by 10.4% and 38.0% compared to 2015. Despite these trends - the region still has one of the highest unemployment rates in Poland.

Since 2015, the registered unemployment rate in the voivodship has been systematically decreasing to reach 8.8% at the end of 2018 (2015 - 13.2%). The unemployment rate for the whole country was 5.8%, compared to

9.7% in 2015. In the ranking of voivodeships, Podkarpacie was in the 14th place in the country in terms of the unemployment rate. Among the voivodeships of eastern Poland, the higher registered unemployment rate in 2018 occurred only in Warmińsko-Mazurskie (10.4).
